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HOW TO USE THIS REPORT

1. Locate your area of interest on the "Index to Soil Maps"
2. Note the number of the map sheet and request that sheet from the White River Junction NRCS field office.
3. Locate your area of interest on the map sheet.

Each soil map unit is delineated with a black soil boundary line. Within each soil area is a symbol that identifies the kind of soil. The number portion of the symbol identifies the soil type while the letter tells the dominant percent of slope within the mapped area.

4. List the map unit symbols that are in your area of interest.
5. Turn to "Index to Soil Map Units for Windsor County" which lists the names of each map unit and the page where that map unit is described.
6. See "Summary of Tables" for location of additional data on a specific soil use.
7. Consult "Contents" for other parts of the report that will meet your specific needs.
