The Hurricane of '38

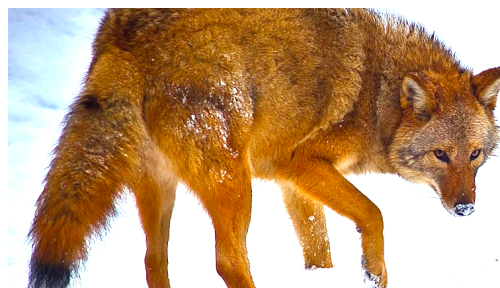

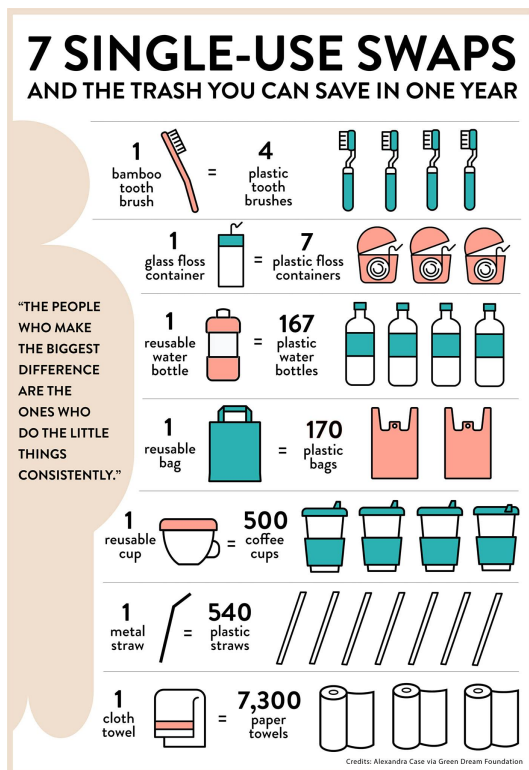
